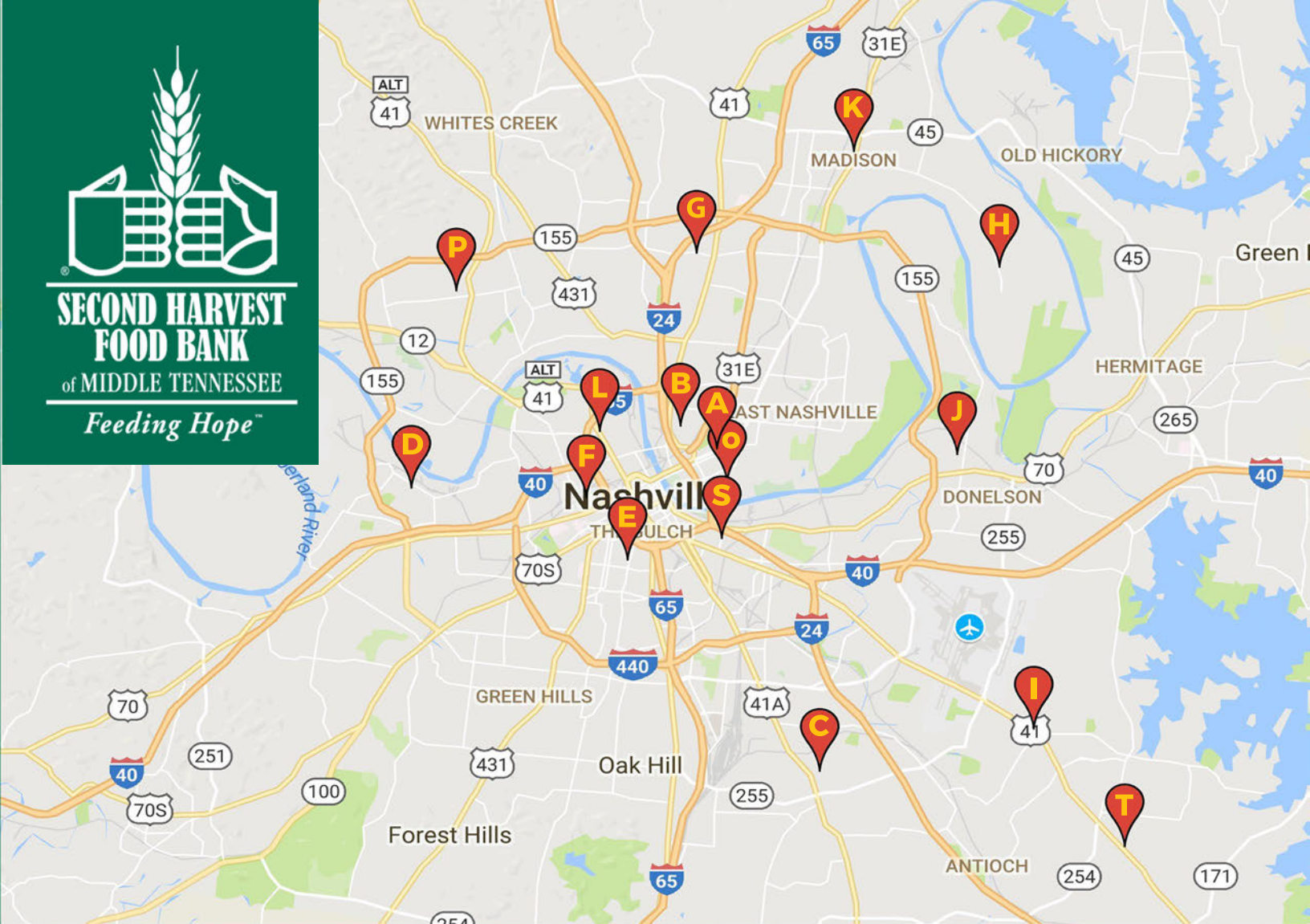

Food Stamps / Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

- You may qualify for SNAP, also known as Food Stamps. Call 615-310-0752 to speak with a Second Harvest Benefits Counselor. We can help you fill out an application over the phone.

WIC - The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children

- This program provides food, baby formula, and nutrition education for pregnant women or families with children under age five. Call 1-800-342-5942 or your local health department for more information.
